Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to outline the upcoming transition visits to Eyemouth High School that have been planned for your young person on Tuesday 9th & Wednesday 10th June.

The purpose of these transition visits is to help establish positive relationships between pupils and staff; give pupils a taste of their timetable and help them learn the systems of the school e.g. using the canteen and finding their way around.

On these days, your young person will need to come prepared to school with the following:

Tuesday 9th & Wednesday 10th June – arrive 8:40am – 3:45pm

- Wearing full Primary School uniform (Primary School leavers hoodies are acceptable, however your young person may be asked to remove this in certain subjects for safety reasons)
- PE kit
- Snack
- Water bottle
- Fully charged iPad (for those within catchment area)

We hope that, as in previous years, P7s will be offered a free school meal in the canteen at lunchtime on both days. We will confirm as soon as we have been informed. If your young person would prefer to bring a packed lunch instead, this is an option too.

Medication

- If your young person requires prescribed medication during the school day, any arrangements currently in place at the Primary Schools (for those within catchment area) will be transferred by staff to the High School for the Transition days.
- If your young person uses an inhaler that they carry on them and self-administer, please make sure they bring it with them on the Transition days.

Transport

- Pupils to use the transport that they will be using in August.

There will be staff and First Year Friends (senior students who have volunteered to support our new S1s) at the front door to welcome and direct.

Further information about the school is included in the Welcome Booklet that was distributed to all P7 pupils by our Home School Link Workers during their visits to High School over the past couple of months.
