Revision Checklist

1. I am spending an **appropriate amount of time revising** each of my subjects each week (at least 90 minutes for National 5 subjects and 2 hours for Higher and Advanced Higher subjects).
2. I have a **Revision Timetable** which I stick to each week.
3. I am using **SQA Course Specifications** to check and self-assess my learning for each of my subjects each week.
4. I am using **SQA Specimen Papers** and **Past Papers** to practice exam-style questions each week for each of my subjects, using **Marking Instructions** to assess how I have done.
5. I am using the **BBC Bitesize website or app**, **Scholar** and/or the **BrightRed website** on a weekly basis to **revise** each of my subjects and to **test** my knowledge.
